Standard Operating Procedures

Anti-Ragging Committee

Purpose:

To prevent and address ragging, ensuring a safe, respectful environment for all students.

1. Objective:

- Prevent ragging and bullying.
- · Raise awareness about its harmful effects.
- Address and resolve ragging complaints.
- Ensure a safe campus free from discrimination.

2. Structure:

Chairperson: Senior faculty or principal.

• Members: Faculty, staff, and student representatives.

3. Functions:

- Prevention & Awareness: Conduct orientation and awareness programs for students.
- Grievance Redressal: Establish accessible reporting mechanisms and ensure confidentiality.
- Investigation & Action: Promptly investigate complaints and take disciplinary action against offenders.
- Support for Victims: Provide counseling and ensure victims' safety.

4. Reporting and Action Procedure:

- 1. Report: Complaints can be made via email, portal, or directly to the committee.
- 2. Immediate Action: Preliminary inquiry and necessary involvement of authorities.
- 3. Investigation: Formal inquiry involving all parties.
- 4. Disciplinary Action: Appropriate actions based on the investigation's outcome (e.g., suspension, expulsion).



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5. Monitoring:

- Regular Inspections: Conduct campus visits to deter ragging.
- Committee Meetings: Regular reviews of ongoing cases and preventive measures.
- Feedback: Collect student feedback on safety concerns.

6. Confidentiality & Ethics:

- Maintain confidentiality for all parties involved.
- Ensure fair, respectful handling of complaints.

7. Awareness & Education:

• Awareness Programs: Inform students about anti-ragging policies at the start of each academic year.
